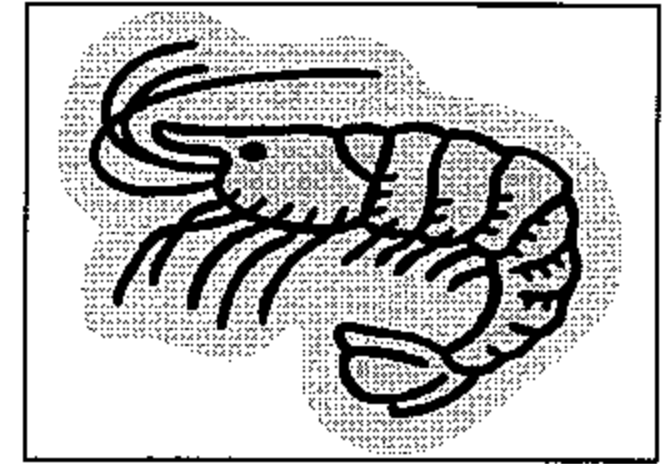

Dear Geoff

After having used your products over the last Tiger season and end of year refit, I can highly recommend the Lanotec products for use in the fishing industry.

Prior to the start of the Tiger season we used your Heavy Duty on everything from hydraulic fittings to the door hinges as a rust inhibitor & lubricant and the Type "A" Grease on our trawl wires as well as the turnbuckles, shackles and blocks. One of the things we did notice is that the lanolin does not wash off in water but leaves a fine film over the metal so as part of our maintenance we would wash down with fresh water and give everything a light spray once a month. The fact that these products are biodegradable and environmentally friendly should give us some brownie points with the "greenies".

Our engineer now sprays all the electricals and all moving parts in the engineroom with the General Purpose which I have also used on the back of the electronics in the wheelhouse to stop corrosion from the salt air. As for the Citra-Force, it is an excellent degreaser and deck wash. A light spray on the hands makes for a great handwash as well.

Now that we have almost finished our refit we found there was no need for an oxy cutter to free up any of the shackles, whether it be on our bison boards or in the rigging. Almost everything looks as good as it did 12 months ago. We also found the General Purpose to be a great anti spatter and cutting oil as you had indicated. Because the Cathy Wren is an aluminium boat we found that giving the aluminium and fiberglass on the sorting tray a spray, it now looks to be rejuvenated and will hopefully stop the deterioration that has now started

After using these products over the last six months, the crew now swears by them and now if we come across any problems the first solution is "Give it a spray". We all think you're on a winner here and good luck with it.
